## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

## RS26313

This legislation is recommended by members of the State Procurement Laws Interim Committee, which met from August to November 2016 to study issues relating to public procurement and to make recommendations. The committee is proposing legislation this session but believes that some issues require further study, including but not limited to, information technology procurement, best practices for information technology procurement, and the State's methods for evaluating future information technology needs.

This resolution authorizes the Legislative Council to appoint an Information Technology Procurement Interim Committee to undertake and complete a study of issues relating to public procurement of information technology and to report its findings and recommendations to the First Regular Session of the Sixty-fifth Idaho Legislature.

## **FISCAL NOTE**

The cost of the study is not expected to exceed \$10,000. The study will be paid for by the Senate and House of Representatives from their existing appropriation in the Legislative Account.
