DOCKET NO. Camille Schiller, Program Manager, Health Coverage Assistance, Department of Health and Welfare (DHW), Division of Welfare, presented **Docket No.**

16-0301-1702 to clarify when a citizen adopted foreign child may begin receiving Medicaid. The eligibility criteria for Medicaid for pregnant women is changed to allow coverage before the baby is born, in alignment with federal guidance. Child and family services eligibility includes reference to the state foster care program.

DOCKET NO. Camille Schiller, Program Manager, Health Coverage Assistance, DHW Division

16-0305-1701: of Welfare, presented **Docket No. 16-0305-1701**. Chapter changes clarify

an individual receiving the Aid to the Aged, Blind and Disabled (AABD) cash supplement must also be receiving Social Security Income payments. Other changes simplify the effective date language and retirement fund definition. The allowance for participants in CFH has been corrected. An exception to asset transfer rules penalty has been added in compliance with federal guidance.

covered age groups. The effective date is July 1, 2018.

Ericka Rupp, Program Manager, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), 16-0308-1701: DHW, Division of Welfare, presented **Docket No. 16-0308-1701** and requested it be rejected by the committee because it does not cover all of the needed changes. Ericka Rupp, Program Manager, Idaho Child Care Program, DHW Division of DOCKET NO. 16-0612-1701: Welfare, presented **Docket No. 16-0612-1701**, with changes to the Idaho Child Care Program (ICCP). Updates are made for clear communication of definitions and chapter consistency. Clarification is also made to income consideration, payment for care, overpayment recovery, graduated benefits phase out, and safe sleep as a part of the ICCP certification.
