STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS26472

The State Board of Midwifery is proposing legislation to remove obsolete language regarding Board appointments; to update the list of formulary drugs that midwives are authorized to use; to remove obsolete grandmother language from qualifications for licensure; and to clarify the requirements regarding practice data required for license renewal. This legislation will clarify the Board's laws, modernize the drugs midwives can utilize, and simplify licensees' reporting requirements.

FISCAL NOTE

There is no impact to the General Fund or the Idaho Bureau of Occupational Licenses' dedicated fund because the proposed legislation will not alter the number of board meetings held each year or require more services be provided to the State Board of Midwifery.
