STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This legislation is an attempt to create clarity in Idaho code with regard to a new category of bicycles increasingly popular on Idaho roads, paths and trails.

These bicycles utilize small electronic motors to provide a boost to the rider on hills or flat roads where extra speed is desirable. They are called "E-bikes" and have all the features common to regular bicycles.

Bicycle manufacturers have agreed on an industry standard to create three basic categories of E-bikes. This legislation incorporates those categories into state law, and uses them to establish a framework for how cities, counties and the state regulate the use of E-bikes, without preemption. Local control will remain in place.

This legislation also clarifies that E-bikes are not mopeds or motorcycles and they will have to follow all existing laws and "rules of the road" for bicycles.
