Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 14, Title 49, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 49-1401B, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

49-1401B. USE OF A HANDHELD WIRELESS DEVICE WHILE DRIVING. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 49-1401A, Idaho Code, no city, county, or other political subdivision of this state shall enact a regulation, resolution, or ordinance that prohibits or restricts the use of a handheld wireless device while driving a moving motor vehicle. Any such regulation, resolution, or ordinance implemented prior to the effective date of this act shall be null, void, and of no force and effect on and after July 1, 2019.
