- RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; AMENDING CHAPTER 6, TITLE 49, IDAHO CODE, BY THE 2 ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 49-675, IDAHO CODE, TO PROHIBIT SMOKING, VA-3 PING, OR IGNITING AN OBJECT OR ACTIVATING A DEVICE FOR THE PURPOSE OF 4 5 SMOKING OR VAPING IN A MOTOR VEHICLE IF A MINOR IS PRESENT, TO PROVIDE THAT ENFORCEMENT OF THIS SECTION MAY BE ACCOMPLISHED ONLY AS A SECONDARY 6 ACTION, TO PROVIDE A PENALTY, TO PROVIDE THAT CONVICTION UNDER THIS SEC-7 TION SHALL NOT RESULT IN VIOLATION POINT COUNTS OR BE CONSIDERED A MOV-8 ING TRAFFIC VIOLATION, AND TO DEFINE TERMS. 9
- 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 6, Title 49, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 49-675, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

49-675. SMOKING OR VAPING IN MOTOR VEHICLE WITH MINOR PRESENT. (1) If a
 person under the age of eighteen (18) years is present in a motor vehicle, no
 operator of or passenger in the vehicle shall:

18 (b) Ignite an object for the purpose of smoking; or

(c) Activate a device for the purpose of vaping.

(2) Enforcement of this section by law enforcement officers may be ac complished only as a secondary action when the operator of the motor vehicle
 has been detained for a suspected violation of another law.

(3) A person issued a citation pursuant to this section shall be subject
to a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00). A conviction under this section shall
not result in violation point counts as prescribed in section 49-326, Idaho
Code, nor shall such a conviction be deemed to be a moving traffic violation
for the purpose of establishing rates of motor vehicle insurance charged by a
casualty insurer.

29 (4) For purposes of this section:

- 30 (a) "Smoke" means to inhale and exhale the fumes of a tobacco product or31 another drug; and
- 32 (b) "Vape" means to inhale vapor through the mouth from a device that33 heats up and vaporizes a liquid or solid.
