This memorial would state that the Idaho Legislature is requesting Congress to release all wilderness study areas acreage which has already been listed as "not suitable for wilderness" by the BLM and relayed to President George HW Bush in 1992, in order to return the lands to public use. The Idaho Legislature supports current peer-reviewed scientific management in implementing the multiples-use concept of public land use to ensure the protection and improvement of forest health, to maintain and improve the sustainability of federal forests located in Idaho and reduce the risk of harm to human health and the environment.
