5	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 18, Title 41, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a  $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$ , to be known and designated as Section 41-1853, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

41-1853. ANTICANCER MEDICATIONS. (1) For purposes of this section:

- (a) "Anticancer medication" means a drug or biologic used to kill, slow, or prevent the growth of cancerous cells, whether administered orally, intravenously, or by injection.
- (b) "Health benefit plan" shall have the same meaning as provided in section 41-5903, Idaho Code.
- (2) A health benefit plan covering anticancer medications determined to be necessary by a licensed oncologist and ordered by a licensed oncologist shall not assign a higher copayment, deductible, or coinsurance amount for a patient-administered anticancer medication than for an injected or intravenously administered anticancer medication.
- (3) A health benefit plan covering an anticancer medication is not required to classify the anticancer medication as a medical benefit.
- (4) A health benefit plan that provides coverage of anticancer medications cannot comply with the provisions of subsection (2) of this section by:
  - (a) Increasing the copayment, deductible, or coinsurance amount required for an anticancer medication covered under the health benefit plan; or
  - (b) Reclassifying benefits with respect to anticancer medications.
