

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS26700

This bill amends Idaho Code §§ 25-1122 and 25-1160 establishing increased maximum fees for ownership and transportation certifications; increased maximum brand inspection fees for, horses, mules, and asses; to provide for equine farm service fees; and to make technical corrections. Section 25-1122 specifically sets the maximum amount for the ownership and transportation certificate to be \$75.00. Section 25-1160 raises the cattle inspection fee from \$1.19 to \$1.25, and the maximum fee that can be charged to \$10 for each head of horses, mules, and asses. Finally, § 25-1122 determines that the equine service fee shall not exceed \$55.00.

FISCAL NOTE

There is no impact to, or appropriation from the General Fund. All increases in fees are received by the Idaho State Government Brand Board and directed towards the Brand Board, Idaho State Department of Agriculture, Agriculture Data Coalition, Beef Council and the Horse Board.
