## BY STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

4	RESTATEMENT OF THE LAW SHALL NOT BE RECOGNIZED.

- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 6 SECTION 1. That Section 73-116, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 7 amended to read as follows:
  - 73-116. COMMON LAW IN FORCE. <u>(1)</u> The common law of England, so far as it is not repugnant to, or inconsistent with, the constitution or laws of the United States, in all cases not provided for in these compiled laws, is the rule of decision in all courts of this state.
  - (2) In any action governed by the law of this state concerning the rights and obligations arising in connection with, under, or from a liability insurance policy, the constitution of the United States and the constitution of the state of Idaho, the law expressed in the statutes and rules of this state, and the common law and case law precedent from this state shall apply. The American law institute's "Restatement of the Law, Liability Insurance" is not a source of Idaho law and shall not be afforded recognition as an authoritative reference regarding Idaho's liability insurance law.
