This Joint Memorial between the Idaho Senate and House urges Congress to ratify the agreement of the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA) as soon as possible. It also encourages President Trump's administration to renew its original waiver on steel and aluminum tariffs for Canada and Mexico.
