Chairman Brackett convened the meeting of the Senate Transportation Committee (Committee) at 1:30 p.m.
Senator Den Hartog moved to approve the Minutes of January 15, 2019. Senator Winder seconded the motion. The motion passed by voice vote .
Chairman Brackett invited Senator Harris to present S 1046.
Senator Harris said this legislation increases the threshold of the value of personal and real property owned by local highway districts that can be sold without prior public notice from \$5,000 to \$10,000. The statute was last updated in 2003, and making this change has no fiscal impact on the General Fund. He said Gordon Bates, Director of the Golden State Highway District #3 in Wilder, was available for any technical questions the Committee might have. Senator Harris stood for questions.
Senator Den Hartog asked for an example of what would constitute the type of property affected by this change. Senator Harris suggested an old dump truck or sand truck with a market value of less than \$10,000.
Senator Nelson moved to send S 1046 to the floor with a do pass recommendation. Senator Winder seconded the motion. The motion passed by voice vote. Senator Harris would carry the bill on the Senate floor.
Chairman Brackett said he was prepared to present RS 26758 and RS 26759C1, but a motion was called for by the Committee.
Senator Winder moved to send RS 26758 and RS 26759C1 to print. Senator Buckner-Webb seconded the motion. The motion passed by voice vote.
With no further business before the Committee, Chairman Brackett adjourned the meeting at 1:37 p.m.
