4	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
5 6	SECTION 1. That Section 19-3508, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
7 8	19-3508. ELIGIBILITY FOR DIVERSION PROGRAM. A person is eligible to participate in a diversion program if:
9 10	(1) The person has been charged with driving under the influence pursuant to section 18-8004 or 18-8004A, Idaho Code;
11	(2) At the time of the conduct underlying such charge, the person:
12	(a) Did not hold a commercial driver's license or commercial
13	<pre>learner's permit; or</pre>
14	(b) Was not operating a commercial vehicle;
15	(3) No other person is alleged to have been physically injured as a re-
16	sult of the conduct underlying such charge; and
17	(34) The person charged has not been convicted of driving under the in-
18	fluence or a substantially conforming foreign criminal violation within the
19	past ten (10) years and has not previously participated in a diversion pro-

gram pursuant to section 19-3509, Idaho Code.
