- RELATING TO FAMILY LAW LICENSE SUSPENSIONS; AMENDING CHAPTER 14, TITLE 7, 2 IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 7-1410A, IDAHO CODE, TO PRO-3 VIDE FOR CERTAIN TEMPORARY RESTRICTED LICENSES. 4
- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 5
- SECTION 1. That Chapter 14, Title 7, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 6 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-7 ignated as Section 7-1410A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows: 8

7-1410A. FAMILY LAW TEMPORARY RESTRICTED LICENSE. (1) With respect to 9 a person whose driver's license would otherwise be valid if not for a family 10 law license suspension ordered by a court, licensing authority, or the de-11 partment pursuant to section 7-1410, Idaho Code, a licensee may petition the 12 court for an order that a licensing authority issue a temporary restricted 13 driver's license if such licensee shows good cause as to why such a license 14 should be issued. 15

(2) For purposes of this section, a licensee may demonstrate good cause 16 by showing that a temporary restricted driver's license is necessary for the 17 licensee's employment purposes in order to meet child support obligations. 18

(3) A temporary restricted license shall specify the restrictions as 19 to certain times, days, and areas of use and any further restrictions as the 20 court, in its discretion, may impose. 21

22 (4) A temporary restricted license shall be revoked if a licensee holding such license is found to be in violation of the restrictions imposed upon 23 such temporary restricted license. 24

(5) An order issuing a temporary restricted license by the court shall 25 also state that the temporary restricted licensee is subject to the penal-26 ties of the licensing authority if the restrictions of the license are vio-27 28 lated.

(6) An order issuing a temporary restricted license by a court shall be 29 forwarded to the appropriate licensing authority. 30
