### STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

## RS27496 / H0436

This legislation transfers the responsibilities for the health care directive registry from the Secretary of State to the Department of Health and Welfare, including the existing records.

# **FISCAL NOTE**

The cost to design, build, and implement an advanced care directive database system in the Department of Health and Welfare is estimated at about \$250,000 onetime. The design and buildout can be funded at a 90% federal share using HITECH funds and 10% state match.

It will cost \$500,000 ongoing for operation. The ongoing operations will be a mix of 75% federal share and 25% state match for Medicaid eligible participants and 100% General Fund for non-Medicaid, which averages out to an approximate 50/50 fund split for ongoing operations in a full year.

Design and buildout: \$25,000 General Fund; \$225,000 federal funds

Ongoing operations, outreach, and trainings: \$250,000 General Fund; \$250,000 federal funds
