Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 16, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$, to be known and designated as Section 33-1636, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

33-1636. READING RESOURCES -- LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. The legislature finds that reading skills are paramount to students' academic and career success. The legislature further finds that not all schools are able to provide adequate access to academic texts to support student learning. To ensure that districts and schools have adequate resources, the state department of education shall make available a statewide online student literacy and academic text support system. The support system shall offer unlimited access to authentic, nonfiction texts personalized for students, match texts to students based on age and lexile reading level, and allow the classroom teacher to monitor student engagement and growth.
