Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 10, Title 54, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 54-1011, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 54-1011. DIRECT SUPERVISION. (1) It shall be the responsibility of an employing electrical contractor to ensure that apprentices perform electrical work only under constant on-the-job supervision of a journeyman electrician. It shall be the responsibility of an employing electrical contractor to determine how to provide such supervision on a case-by-case basis, including with respect to how many apprentices a journeyman electrician may supervise.
- (2) There shall be no journeyman electrician-to-apprentice ratio. A journeyman electrician may supervise as many apprentices as may be provided constant on-the-job supervision pursuant to this section.
- (3) Failure to provide constant on-the-job supervision of an apprentice pursuant to this section may be grounds for suspension or revocation of an electrical contractor's license.
