## SENATE BILL NO. 1335

## BY STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

AN ACT

- RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE; AMENDING SECTION 67-404, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE
  THAT EACH REGULAR LEGISLATIVE SESSION SHALL ADJOURN SINE DIE BY A CER TAIN DATE, TO PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION, AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.
- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 67-404, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 7 amended to read as follows:

8 67-404. SESSIONS OF LEGISLATURE. At the hour of twelve o'clock M 12:00 p.m. on the Monday on or nearest the ninth day in January, the regular ses-9 sion of the legislature shall be convened. The presiding officer must call 10 the same to order and preside. Neither house must transact any business, 11 12 but must adjourn from day to day, until a majority of all the members authorized by law to be elected are present. Each legislature shall have a term 13 of two (2) years, commencing on December 1 next following the general elec-14 tion, and shall consist of a "First Regular Session," which shall meet in the 15 odd-numbered years and a "Second Regular Session $\underline{\prime}$ " which shall meet in the 16 even-numbered years and any extraordinary session or sessions which that may 17 be called as provided by law. Each regular legislative session shall adjourn 18 sine die on or before the last Friday in March. Notwithstanding the provi-19 sions of this section, the legislature is not precluded from remaining in 20 session beyond the last Friday in March for the purpose of acting on a possi-21 22 ble gubernatorial veto.
