The State Board of Education shall report to the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee by January 10, 2021, regarding the current balance in the Opportunity Scholarship Program Account and the estimated obligation due to any over-award or early award of scholarships for fiscal year 2022. The report shall include an estimate of the necessary balance in the account to meet these obligations.
