RS 27813:	<b>Rep. Blanksma</b> presented <b>RS 27813</b> , proposed legislation that would allow a refund provision of up to 50% of the tax levied and would be paid quarterly to the Idaho Potato Commission.
MOTION:	Rep. Moyle made a motion to introduce RS 27813. Motion carried by voice vote.
RS 27905:	<b>Rep. Bedke</b> , Speaker of the House, presented <b>RS 27905,</b> proposed legislation regarding stockwater rights. In reference to previously introduced legislation, Rep. Bedke explained changes in <b>RS 27905.</b> He indicated that an additional amendment needed to be made.
MOTION:	<b>Rep. Moyle</b> made a motion to introduce <b>RS 27905</b> with the following change: to strikeout "nor any agent acting on its behalf," on Page 3, Line 26. <b>Motion carried by voice vote.</b>
RS 27878:	Rep. Chaney presented RS 27878, proposed replacement legislation for H 468 regarding firearm rights in Idaho.
MOTION:	Rep. Monks made a motion to introduce RS 27878. Motion carried by voice vote.
RS 27909:	<b>Rep. Rubel</b> presented <b>RS 27909</b> , proposed replacement legislation for <b>H 459</b> that would require landlords to give tenants a 30 day notice for a raise in rent or intentions to not renew the lease on residential properties.
MOTION:	Rep. McCrostie made a motion to introduce RS 27909. Motion carried by voice vote.
RS 27911:	<b>Rep. Wintrow</b> presented <b>RS 27911</b> , proposed replacement legislation for <b>H 462</b> that would define a process to allow tenants and landlords to do a walkthrough of the premises for rent and allow for an itemized receipt of charges.
MOTION:	Rep. Rubel made a motion to introduce RS 27911. Motion carried by voice vote.
RS 27842:	<b>Rep. Moyle,</b> in place of <b>Rep. Troy,</b> presented <b>RS 27842,</b> proposed legislation that would recommend the use of Idaho grown wood products.
MOTION:	Rep. Moyle made a motion to introduce RS 27842. Motion carried by voice vote.
