- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 6 SECTION 1. That Chapter 9, Title 44, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 7 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des-8 ignated as Section 44-906, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
 - 44-906. USE OF EARNED OR ACCRUED SICK LEAVE. (1) It shall be unlawful for an employer that offers sick leave to its employees to:
 - (a) Count earned or accrued sick leave taken in accordance with the employer's written sick leave policy as an absence that results in discipline or any other adverse action; or
 - (b) Restrict an employee from using earned or accrued sick leave for the employee's illness, injury, health condition, or need for medical diagnosis.
 - (2) Nothing in this section shall be construed as creating a new financial obligation to an employee from an employer upon the employee's termination, resignation, retirement, or other separation from employment for earned or accrued sick leave that has not been used.
