- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 5
- SECTION 1. That Chapter 23, Title 18, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-7 ignated as Section 18-2324, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
 - 18-2324. BALLOT COLLECTION PROHIBITED -- EXCEPTIONS. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a person may not knowingly collect or convey another voter's voted or unvoted ballot.
 - (2) This section does not apply to:
 - (a) An election official in the performance of his official duties;
 - (b) A United States postal service worker or other individual specifically authorized by law to transmit United States mail in the performance of his official duties;
 - (c) An employee or contractor of a parcel delivery business that receives and delivers parcels in all states within the United States in the performance of his official duties; or
 - (d) An individual related to the voter by adoption, marriage, or blood within the second degree of consanguinity, if authorized by the voter to convey the voter's ballot.
 - (3) An individual authorized to collect and convey a voter's ballot pursuant to subsection (2) (d) of this section may not collect or convey more than six (6) such ballots at a time.
 - (4) A violation of the provisions of this section constitutes a felony.
