HOUSE BILL NO. 397

BY APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE

AN ACT RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC WORKS; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE PERMANENT BUILDING FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE PERMANENT BUILDING FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DE-PARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022; PROVIDING FOR COST RECOVERY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. CASH TRANSFER. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$100,000 from the General Fund to the Permanent Building Fund as soon as practicable for the period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021.

SECTION 2. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 184, Laws of 2020, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Department of Administration for the Division of Public Works \$100,000 from the Permanent Building Fund to be expended for capital outlay for the period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021, for the purpose of renovation of the east wing of the first floor of the Idaho State Capitol Building.

- SECTION 3. CASH TRANSFER. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$1,900,000 from the General Fund to the Permanent Building Fund on July 1, 2021, or as soon thereafter as practicable for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022.
- SECTION 4. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Department of Administration for the Division of Public Works \$1,900,000 from the Permanent Building Fund to be expended for capital outlay for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, for the purpose of renovation of the east wing of the first floor of the Idaho State Capitol Building.
- SECTION 5. COST RECOVERY. To the extent possible, and based on federal guidelines, recovery of state dollars should be sought with funding available from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, P.L. 117-2, to offset expenditure of General Fund moneys appropriated in this act. If cost offsets are allowable, the Division of Financial Management shall request the Office of the State Controller to transfer an amount not to exceed the allowable costs

- from the American Rescue Plan Fund to the American Rescue Plan Cost Recovery Fund.
- 3 SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 4 declared to exist, Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall be in full force and ef-5 fect on and after passage and approval. Sections 3, 4, and 5 of this act shall 6 be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2021.
