3	ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 39-4810, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE CERTAIN VACCI-
4	NATION EXEMPTIONS.

- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
  - SECTION 1. That Chapter 48, Title 39, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 39-4810, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
    - 39-4810. VACCINATION EXEMPTIONS. This section shall supersede any conflicting rules or orders issued by local officials. No entity in the state of Idaho can compel receipt of a vaccine by any individual, including an employee or a consumer, who objects to such vaccination for any reason of personal conscience or religious beliefs or for medical reasons, including the presence of antibodies or T-cell response to the virus the vaccine is meant to protect against. All relevant statutes are suspended to the extent necessary to enforce these exemptions.
