STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS28226 / S1031

The purpose of this legislation is to amend Section 46-1005A by inserting language allowing for the recovery of Federal Funds after a Declaration of State Emergency has expired or was terminated. To provide language to allow the Legislature by concurrent resolution to approve the Governor's request to exceed one percent (1%) of the annual appropriation of general fund moneys being transferred to the disaster emergency account.

To add a severability clause and to declare an emergency clause and to declare an emergency clause allowing the Bill to become effective upon passage.

FISCAL NOTE

The fiscal impact of this legislation will have no impact on the general funds of the state of Idaho because it does not require the expenditure of state funds. It actually limits the transfer of funds to the disaster emergency account to 1% of the annual appropriation of general fund moneys.
