AN ACT

- RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE; AMENDING SECTION 67-404, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE
 THAT EACH REGULAR LEGISLATIVE SESSION SHALL ADJOURN SINE DIE BY A CER TAIN DATE, TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS, AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.
- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 67-404, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 7 amended to read as follows:

8 67-404. SESSIONS OF LEGISLATURE. (1) At the hour of twelve o'clock M 12:00 p.m. on the Monday on or nearest the ninth day in January, the requ-9 lar session of the legislature shall be convened. The presiding officer must 10 call the same to order and preside. Neither house must transact any busi-11 12 ness, but must adjourn from day to day, until a majority of all the members authorized by law to be elected are present. Each legislature shall have a 13 term of two (2) years, commencing on December 1 next following the general 14 election, and shall consist of a "First Regular Session," which shall meet 15 in the odd-numbered years and a "Second Regular Session," which shall meet in 16 the even-numbered years and any extraordinary session or sessions which that 17 may be called as provided by law. 18

19 (2) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, each regular leg-20 islative session shall adjourn sine die on or before 11:59 p.m. on the last 21 Friday in March. The legislature may remain in regular session beyond such 22 date and time:

- 23 (a) For the sole purpose of addressing a gubernatorial veto or vetoes,
 24 or potential gubernatorial veto or vetoes; or
- (b) In the event of an unforeseen anomaly such as a disaster, emergency,
 or extreme peril.
