

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS28314 / S1034

This is an FY 2021 supplemental appropriation bill for the Commission of Pardons and Parole. First, the bill creates the Federal COVID-19 Relief Fund to account for receipts, disbursements, and reimbursements related to the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, and any other federal stimulus moneys subsequently received by the state of Idaho. Second, the bill provides \$50,000 for extradition transport and \$20,000 for parole hearing minute-taking from the newly created fund.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill provides an additional appropriation of \$70,000 in onetime operating expenditures from the Federal COVID-19 Relief Fund to the Commission of Pardons and Parole for FY 2021.
