STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS28262 / S1084

This legislation relating to occupational licensing reform and provides for the regular review of existing licensure requirements and regulations also known as a "sunset" review. The sunset process is intended to determine the appropriateness and necessary of existing regulation and provides a regular opportunity to reduce or eliminate unnecessary regulation. It provides the framework for the sunset review process and the criteria to be evaluated when determining whether existing regulations are still necessary and appropriate. This responsibility will be incorporated into the duties of the existing Sunrise Review Committee.

FISCAL NOTE

These regular sunset reviews will require one additional administrative staff person in the Legislative Services Office. It is estimated that this position would have a fiscal impact of \$70,000, which includes salary, benefits, and some one-time expenses for office items. The position would then be subject to the ongoing budget and appropriation process for the Legislative Services Office. The meetings of the committee will require some expense associated with travel and so on, which is anticipated to be less than \$10,000 annually.
