AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION 2 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE OFFICE OF 3 THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021; INCREASING THE NUMBER 4 5 OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; DIRECTING THE USE OF AP-PROPRIATED FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 6

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 7

8 SECTION 1. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-9 ter 316, Laws of 2020, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Office of the State Board of Education the follow-10 ing amounts to be expended according to the designated expense classes from 11 the listed funds for the period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021, for the 12 13 purpose of administering an early childhood education grant:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In addition to the authorization pro-23 vided in Section 2, Chapter 316, Laws of 2020, the full-time equivalent 24 position authorization provided to the Office of the State Board of Educa-25 tion is hereby increased by fifty-hundredths (0.50) for the period July 1, 26 2020, through June 30, 2021, for the purpose of administering an early child-27 hood education grant. 28

USE OF FUNDS. Moneys appropriated in Section 1 of this act SECTION 3. 29 for the Preschool Development Grant Birth through Five Renewal shall not be 30 used to dictate curricula for use by local collaboratives. Local collabo-31 32 rative stakeholder participation shall include: parents/families, early childhood educators, a representative from the State Board of Education, 33 at least one (1) representative from the local K-12 school district and/or 34 35 charter school, and at least three (3) community participants from a mix of public, private, nonprofit, faith-based, government, health care, and civic 36 37 organizations. Local collaboratives shall be financially self-sufficient, relying on local funding sources after the activities of the Preschool De-38

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velopment Grant Birth through Five Renewal are completed. The State Board of
 Education shall oversee the grant and sub-grantees to ensure the activities,

3 projects, objectives, and outcomes are met and that federal requirements,

4 reports, and deadlines outlined in the grant award are satisfied.

5 SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its

7 passage and approval.
