S1033:	RELATING TO THE LEGISLATIVE ACCOUNT; Amending section 67-451, Idaho code, to revise provisions regarding the transfer of funds into the legislative account; and declaring an emergency and providing retroactive application. Paul Headlee, LSO Analyst.	
	Mr. Headlee presented the \$1033 . This bill would increase the transfers to the legislative account on an annual basis from the current amount of \$6,755,000 to \$8,511,000. This annual increase of \$1,756,000 is split between the Senate and the House. The Senate receives 37% and the House receives 63%. The House receives, of this amount, \$4,225,650. The Senate receives \$2,529,350. This funcis perpetually and continuously appropriated. There are four transfers each year to the legislative account and for this year it would be retroactive to January 1st.
