STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS29259 / H0529

The purpose of this proposal is to eliminate the requirement for license plates to have decals to identify when the associated registration expires. The need for these decals has waned over the past several decades with the advent of technology that allows law enforcement to search a plate records and obtain all relevant details instantaneously. Additionally with the introduction of two-year registrations, the existing color options of decals have become less meaningful.

FISCAL NOTE

The DMV will save \$350,000 year one and \$650,000 each subsequent year in dedicated funds for the elimination of the specialty decal paper and specialty printers. Citizens who renew online will collectively save an additional \$275,000 in postage costs. The total savings for year one is \$625,000 and the total savings for each subsequent year is \$825,000.
