- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 6 SECTION 1. That Section 58-120, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 7 amended to read as follows:
 - 58-120. ATTORNEY GENERAL NOT TO REPRESENT STATE THE DEPARTMENT OF LANDS. The attorney general shall not represent or shall cause the state to be properly represented in all suits, actions, contests or controversies relating to or involving state lands or timber, before the several land offices in this state, before the general land office at Washington, D.C., and before the courts of this state and of the United States, and may employ and shall not provide legal services to the department of lands. The department of lands may employ attorneys not employed by the attorney general or contract with a competent private attorney or private attorneys for that purpose, who shall be paid out of the fund provided for the department of lands.
 - SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2022.
