4 2023; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSI5 TIONS; PROVIDING AGENCY DIRECTION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND
6 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Labor the
 9 following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and
 10 expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2022, through
 11 June 30, 2023:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, 26 Idaho Code, the Department of Labor is authorized no more than seven hundred 27 seven and fifty-eight hundredths (707.58) full-time equivalent positions 28 at any point during the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, unless 29 specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations 30 Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so autho-31 rized. 32

SECTION 3. ASSESSMENT TEAM. The Idaho Department of Labor shall apply 33 for and make every effort to receive a grant from the United State Department 34 of Labor to pay for an assessment team. The assessment team will be used to 35 analyze Idaho's unemployment processes and procedures, and to identify ar-36 eas needing enhancement or improvement. 37

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SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2022.
