STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS29836 / H0785

This is the FY 2023 original appropriation bill for the Commission of Pardons and Parole. It appropriates a total of \$3,879,500 and caps the number of authorized full-time equivalent positions at 37.00. For benefit costs, the bill increases the appropriated amount for health insurance by \$850 to \$12,500 per eligible full time FTP, includes a one-year holiday of unemployment insurance, and adjusts workers' compensation amounts. The bill also provides funding for permanent employees for the equivalent of a 3% salary structure shift and provides \$1.25 per hour per eligible employee to be distributed based on merit for change in employee compensation. The bill funds one line item, which provide additional funds for extradition transport.
