- RELATING TO TOBACCO PRODUCTS AND ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES; AMENDING SEC TION 39-5713, IDAHO CODE, TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN LOCAL REGULATION AND
 TAXES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 39-5713, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 7 amended to read as follows:

8 39-5713. LOCAL ORDINANCES PROHIBITED. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to prohibit local units of government from passing ordinances 9 which are more stringent than the provisions of this chapter. Provided how-10 ever, local units of government shall not have the power to require a permit 11 12 or license for the sale or distribution of tobacco products or electronic cigarettes. No local unit of government may adopt or enforce requirements 13 for the regulation, marketing, or sale of tobacco products or electronic 14 smoking devices that are more restrictive than or in addition to this chap-15 ter. No local unit of government may impose or enforce a tax or fee on tobacco 16 products or electronic smoking devices. This section shall not be construed to prevent a local unit of government from regulating the use of tobacco 17 18 products or electronic smoking devices in any public place pursuant to sec-19 tion 39-5511, Idaho Code, or in any other public outdoor area. 20

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2022.
