 ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 67-465, IDAHO CODE, TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATURE TO INTERVENE IN CERTAIN ACTIONS REGARDING CONSTITUTIONALITY OF
 AN IDAHO STATUTE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
 DATE.
- 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Chapter 4, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
9 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des10 ignated as Section 67-465, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

67-465. INTERVENTION IN ACTIONS REGARDING CONSTITUTIONALITY OF A 11 12 STATUTE. When a party to an action challenges in state or federal court the 13 constitutionality of an Idaho statute, facially or as applied, challenges an Idaho statute as violating or being preempted by federal law, or otherwise 14 challenges the construction or validity of an Idaho statute, the legislature 15 may intervene in the action as a matter of right by serving a motion upon the 16 parties as provided in state or federal rules of civil procedure, whichever 17 is applicable. 18

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2022.
