STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS29368C1 / S1291

This bill would allow charter schools flexibility to connect willing and capable adults in their communities to the students who need them by creating a charter school teaching certificate. Teachers must meet educational or professional requirements, and the charter school must agree to provide mentoring and professional development. A charter school certificate would not be transferable to traditional public school.

FISCAL NOTE

There is no additional cost to the general fund because work required to develop a new certificate would be borne by each charter school and paid for with existing funds. The state board of education already receives funding to issue teaching certificates.
