SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Office of the Secretary of State is authorized no more than twenty-nine (29.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 190, Laws of 2021, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the office of the Secretary of State \$50,000 from the General Fund to be expended for operating expenditures for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, for the purpose of election integrity audits.

SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
