5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature pursuant to Section 67-5224, Idaho Code, must
7 approve certain administrative rules that impose a fee or charge by adoption
8 of a concurrent resolution before the rules become effective; and

9 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive 10 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the 11 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-12 islative intent; and

13 WHEREAS, the Senate Resources and Environment Committee and the House
14 Environment, Energy, and Technology Committee reviewed rules that impose a
15 fee or charge adopted by the Department of Environmental Quality as set forth
16 in Docket No. 58-0000-2100F; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that it is in the public interest to adopt this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-19 sion of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Repre-20 sentatives concurring therein, that pending fee rules adopted by the Depart-21 ment of Environmental Quality, as set forth in Docket No. 58-0000-2100F, 22 pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act and submitted through the Of-23 fice of Rules Coordinator to the Legislature for review during the 2022 leg-24 islative session and reviewed by the Senate Resources and Environment Com-25 mittee and the House Environment, Energy, and Technology Committee, be, and 26 the same are hereby approved. 27
