

## Agency Summary & Statutory Authority

The Department of Agriculture's (ISDA) mission is to guarantee Idaho agricultural products are of high quality, disease-free, and meet federal and state laws, rules, and regulations. The department protects consumers and producers from fraud and provides marketing assistance to the industry. ISDA oversees disease, invasive species, and predator control and performs inspections of growers, handlers, and processers of animal, plant, seed, and fertilizer commodities pursuant to Titles 22, and 25, Idaho Code.
