


#### **Program Maintenance**

- Vacancies:
  - Total FTP Count of 17.75
  - 2.75 FTP Vacant
    - Includes Staff Engineer
      position vacant > 1 year

#### District Passthrough Increase (DU 12.01, LBB page 5-18)

- ISWCC distributes Trustee & Benefits Funds to Idaho's 50 Local Soil and Water Conservation Districts
- \$8,500 per fiscal year base allocation per district
  - \$6,000 per fiscal year operations allocation per district
- Remaining appropriation to be distributed based on a maximum of 2:1 ratio, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 to any one district (Idaho Code Section 22-2727)
  - Fiscal Year 2022 match ratio of 1:25:1
