



Agency Summary & Statutory Authority

The Idaho Commission on Aging (ICOA) plans, coordinates, and promotes a statewide network designed to support aging Idahoans live healthy and dignified lives in the communities of their choice. Services are targeted to those most in need and at risk of early institutionalization. Services include meals, transportation, homemaker and caregiver support, and respite services. ICOA also leads the effort to keep aging Idahoans safe through the Adult Protective Services, Ombudsman, and Senior Legal Assistance Program. Direct services are provided through the six Area Agencies on Aging (AAA) and are guided by local area plans specifically developed to address the
