

Agency Summary & Statutory Authority

Authorized in Section 72-1201, Idaho Code, the Workforce Development Council was created under the Office of the Governor through H432 of 2018.

- Increase public awareness of, and access to, career education and training opportunities;
- Improve the effectiveness, quality, and coordination of programs and services designed to maintain a highly skilled workforce;
- Provide for the most efficient use of federal, state, and local workforce development resources;
- Fulfill the requirements of the State Workforce Investment Board as set forth in the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA);
- Develop and oversee procedures, criteria, and performance measures for the Workforce Development Training Fund.

- No General Fund impact
- \$4.3M FY 21 Line item for additional grants
- \$749K FY 22 Line item for youth apprenticeship grants
- Authorized reappropriation from FY 21 into FY 22
