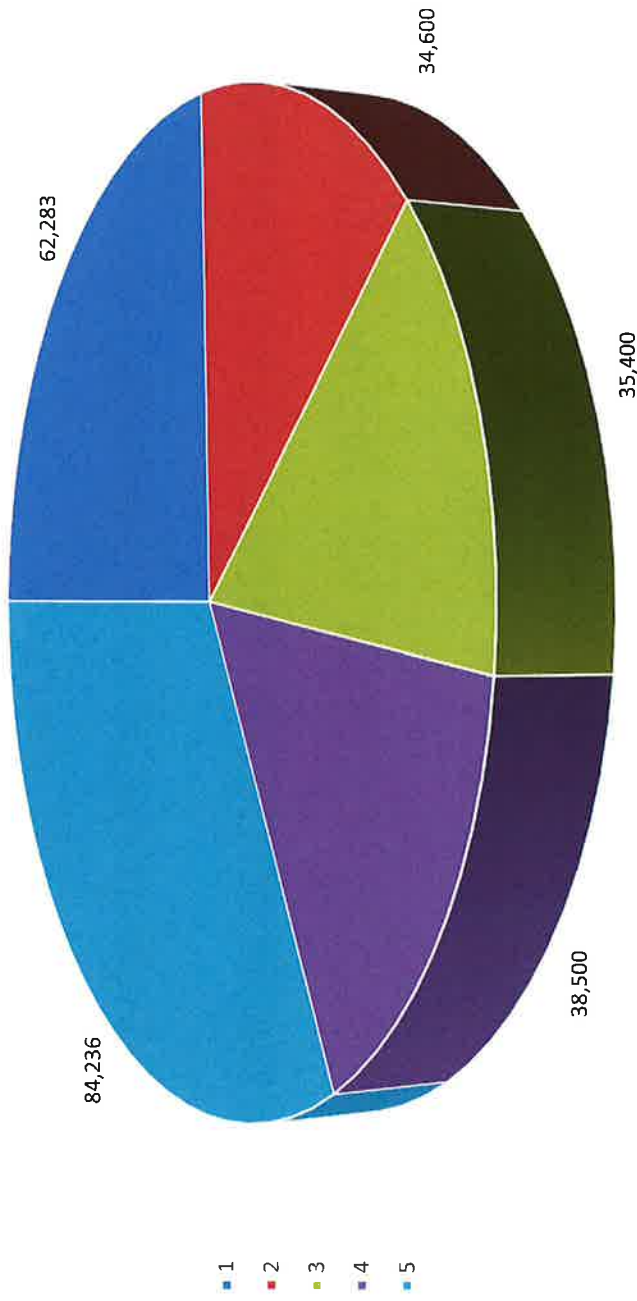

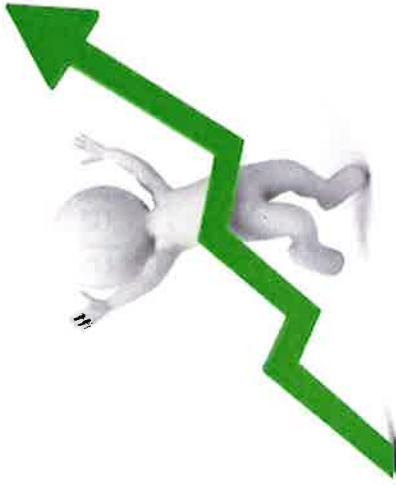

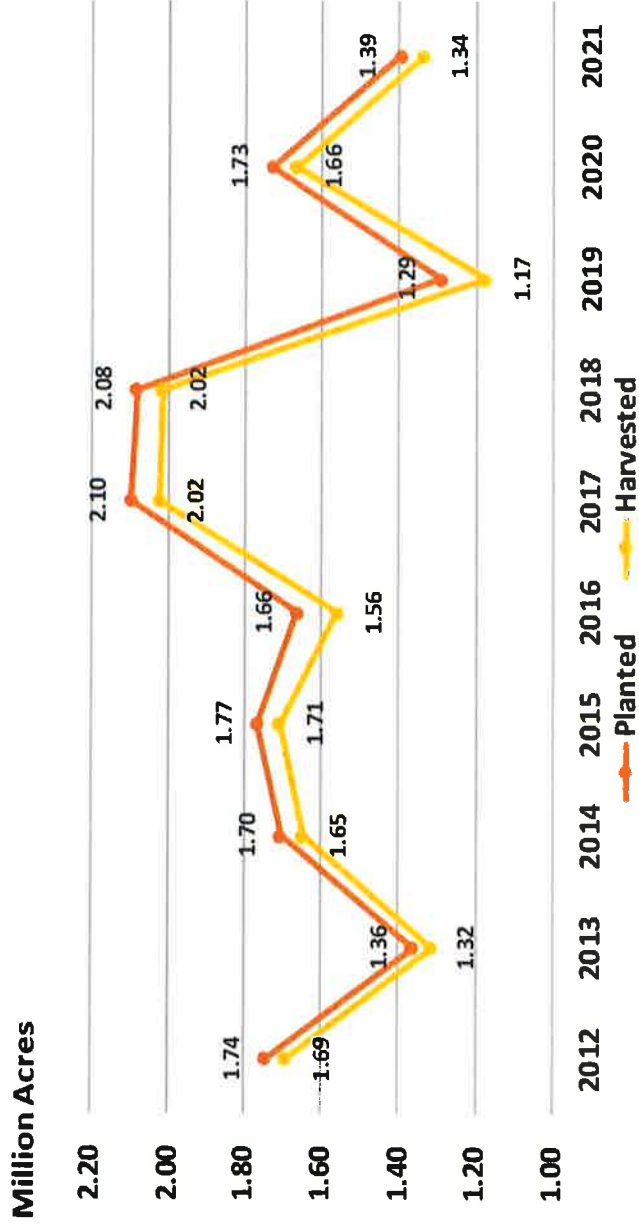




US Dry Bean Acreage



Dry Bean Acres United States



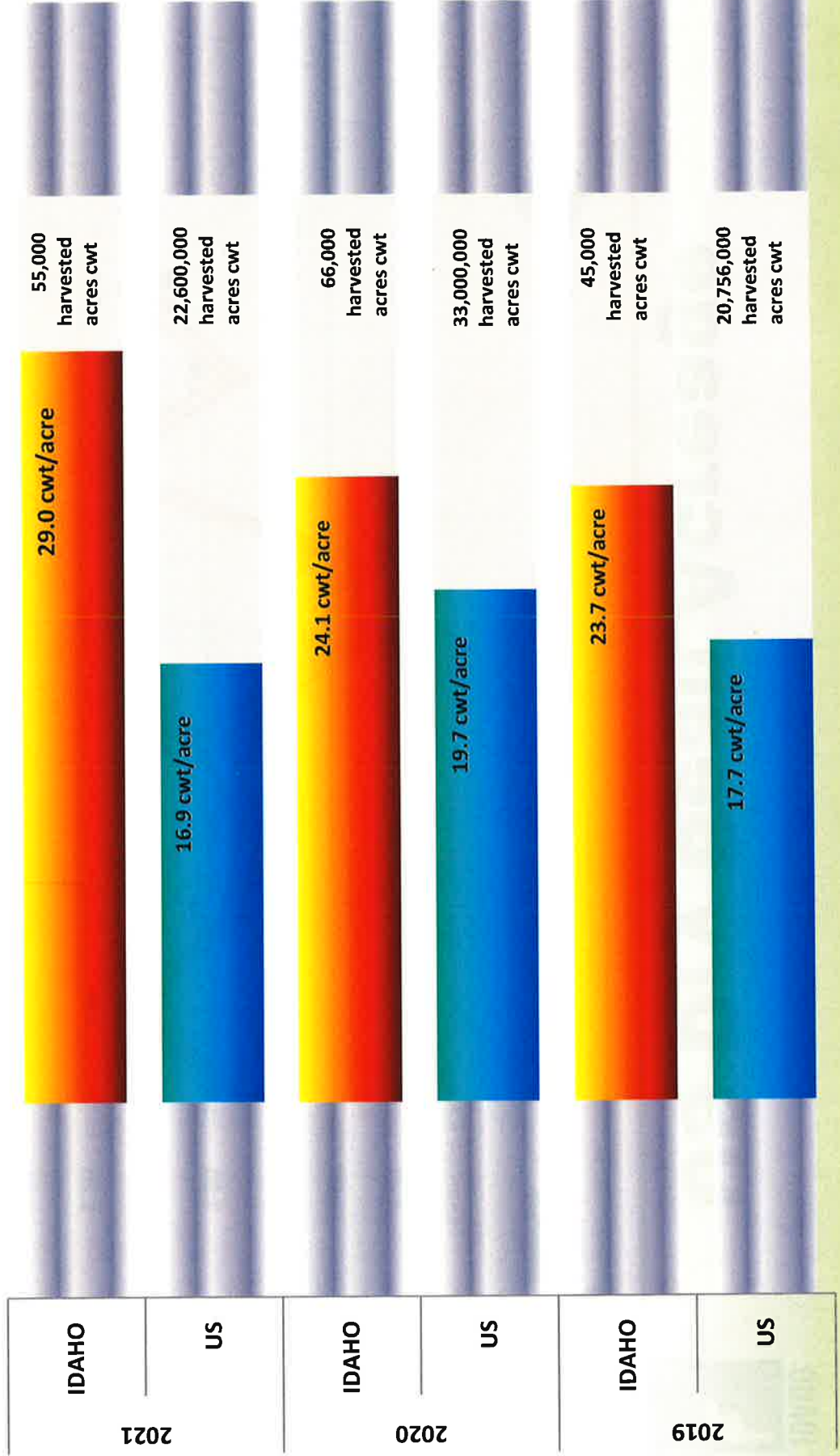

YIELD COMPARISONS of IDAHO vs US in HARVESTED ACRES CWT



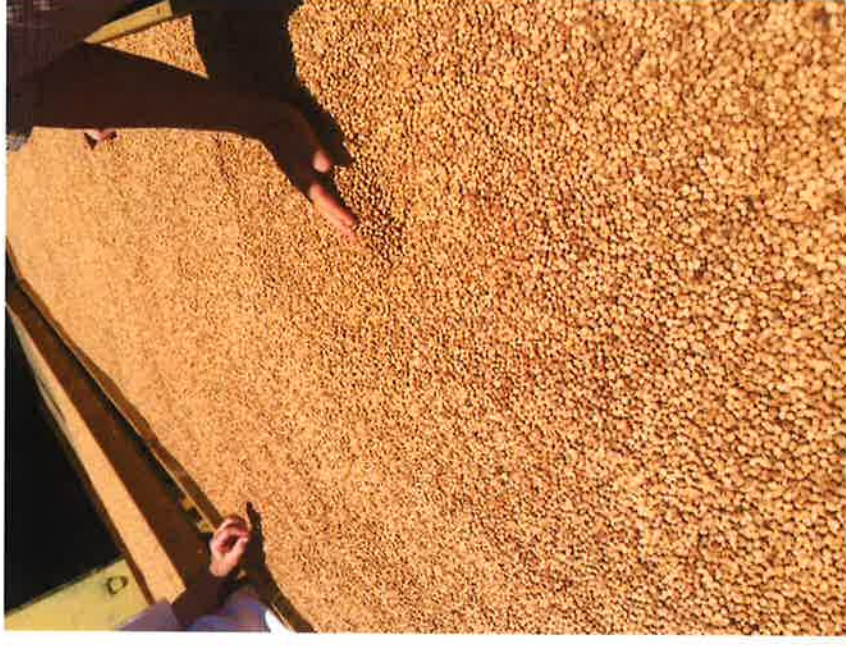
