















Pavement in good or fair condition (Calendar Year: Dec 31)

FY22 Supplementals - Transportation Services

Airport Improvements

\$6,400,000 one-time

- Additional funds to support:
 - Idaho's seven primary airports, community airports and backcountry airstrips

Adjustments- Transportation Services

Replacement Equipment and Other Adjustments

\$3,009,200 ongoing

- Personnel Benefit Costs
- Contract Inflation
- Replacement Items
 - Computer Replacements
 - Server and Network Switch Replacements
 - Other Equipment Replacements
- Statewide Cost Allocation
- 5% Change in Employee Compensation

Software Replacement

\$1,000,000 one-time

- Additional funds to replace ITD's Planning Management Software
 - This management software for the Statewide Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP) was developed years ago
 - Current software has limitations



Aeronautics Equipment and Base Fund Increase

\$381,000 ongoing/one-time

- Increased operating expenditures for new building
- Pilot training
- Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) program development
- Search and Rescue equipment
- Maintenance equipment



Capital Facility Upgrades

\$19,000,000 ongoing

 To address operational facility improvements across the state



Airstrip Maintenance - Capital Facility

\$50,000 ongoing

 Aeronautics Capital Facility program for airstrip building's repairs and maintenance



LUMA Development

\$560,000 one-time

- 3 contractors for Fiscal Year 2023
- Develop interface with ITD software
- Continue contractor payouts



Federal Transportation Spending - IIJA

\$300,000 ongoing

 Federal grants that provide funding for statewide construction job training program

\$3,119,800 ongoing

- Personnel Benefit Costs
- Replacement Items
 - Computer Replacements
 - Scale Deck at Port of Entry
 - Other Equipment Replacements
- Statewide Cost Allocation
- 5% Change in Employee Compensation

Replacement Equipment and Other Adjustments

\$32,620,200 ongoing

- Personnel Benefit Costs
- Replacement Items
 - Computer Replacements
 - Vehicles / Heavy Equipment
 - Other Equipment Replacements
- Statewide Cost Allocation
- 5% Change in Employee Compensation

FY23 Line Items - Highway Operations

Federal Grants- NHTSA, BLM, FTA & CARES

\$10,325,000 ongoing/one-time

- This is pass-through funding for the following grants:
 - The Bureau of Land Management (BLM)
 - National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA)
 - Federal Transit Administration (FTA)
 - FTA CARES Act 2020



FY23 Line Items - Highway Operations

New Equipment Statewide

\$2,900,900 one-time

- Will support statewide maintenance efforts
- Specialty tools for Highway Operations
- Equipment will improve safety on Idaho's highways



FY23 Line Items - Highway Operations

Federal Transportation Funding - IIJA

\$3,305,000 ongoing

- Increased State Highway (Federal) Fund
 - Highway
 - Public Transit
 - Highway safety programs



Contract Construction & Right-of-Way (ROW)

FY22 Supplementals and FY23 Line Items

Railroad Safety Projects

\$8,000,000 one-time

 To address railroad projects targeted to state and local system rail crossings and rail spurs



Local Bridge Maintenance

\$200,000,000 one-time

 Pass-through to Local Highway Transportation Assistance Council (LHTAC)



Pedestrian and Safety Projects

\$10,000,000 one-time

 Pass-through to Local Highway Transportation Assistance Council (LHTAC)



Port of Lewiston Access Road Improvement

\$10,000,000 one-time

 To improve road access and safety to the Port of Lewiston



GARVEE Bond 2012 Final Debt Payment

\$18,485,000 one-time

- Remaining debt in the 2012 GARVEE bond series in FY22
- This is currently the only callable GARVEE bond series available



FY23 Line Items - Contract Construction and ROW

FY23 Construction Program Funding

\$111,859,700 one-time

- Will align spending authority of available resources:
 - State Highway Fund (State/Federal/Local)
 - TECM Fund



FY23 Line Item - Contract Construction and ROW

Roads and Bridge Maintenance

\$200,000,000 ongoing

- To fund road and bridge maintenance across Idaho
 - ITD \$120M
 - Local Jurisdictions \$80M



FY23 Line Items - Contract Construction and ROW

Federal Construction Funding - IIJA

\$124,884,100 ongoing

- Increased State Highway (Federal) Fund
 - Roads, bridges, and other federal programs
- This is the new five-year federal transportation act





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
