- **RS 29578: Rep. Ehardt** presented **RS 29578** proposed legislation, which changes the way school board trustee positions are filled.
- MOTION: Rep. Andrus made a motion to introduce RS 29578. Motion carried by voice vote.
- **RS 29618: Rep. Blanksma** presented **RS 29618** which appeals the \$0.06 excise tax on diesel that is exported from Washington State. This legislation urges **Governor Inslee**, of Washington to veto this bill if it does indeed come to his decision.
- MOTION: Rep. Palmer made a motion to introduce RS 29618.

After questions from the committee, **Rep. Blanksma** reiterated the urgency of this legislation.
