RS 29670	Kate Hass, representing Opportunity Solution Project, presented RS 29670. Ms. Hass explained this legislation was a terminology clean-up bill consistent with the Occupational Licensing Reform Act passed by the Idaho legislature in 2020. The reform bill created a new process for how licensing boards consider an applicant's past criminal convictions. The 2020 bill removed license denial on the basis of terminology, including "moral turpitude" or "moral character." This legislation reduces confusion in the law by updating all Idaho Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing boards statutes.	
UNANIMOUS CONSENT:	Senator Burgoyne asked for unanimous consent to send RS 29670 to the Senate Commerce and Human Resources Committee for printing. There were no objections.
