5	FAITH IS A MISDEMEANOR AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES; AND DECLARING AN EMER-

- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 8 SECTION 1. That Chapter 54, Title 18, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 9 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des-10 ignated as Section 18-5415, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
 - 18-5415. FALSE REPORT OF CHILD ABUSE, ABANDONMENT, OR NEGLECT. Any person who makes a false report of child abuse, abandonment, or neglect knowing such report to be false, or who makes such report in bad faith, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. A person convicted pursuant to this section shall be subject to a fine of up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000), confinement in the county jail for up to three (3) months, or both such fine and confinement.
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
