RELATING TO DRUG COURTS AND MENTAL HEALTH COURTS; AMENDING CHAPTER 56, TITLE
19, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 19-5610, IDAHO CODE,
TO AUTHORIZE COUNSELING SERVICES TO AN ADULT RECEIVING SERVICE THROUGH
A DRUG OR MENTAL HEALTH COURT BY CERTAIN PERSONS AND TO PROVIDE THAT A
PRIOR CRIMINAL CONVICTION SHALL NOT BE AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFYING;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 56, Title 19, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
10 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des11 ignated as Section 19-5610, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

12 19-5610. COUNSELING SERVICE IN DRUG COURTS AND MENTAL HEALTH COURTS. Any licensee licensed under chapter 34, title 54, Idaho Code, who 13 is in good standing with the Idaho state licensing board of professional 14 counselors and marriage and family therapists shall be eligible to provide 15 professional counseling services to an adult receiving service through a 16 drug court or mental health court established pursuant to this chapter. No 17 licensee shall be automatically disqualified from providing professional 18 counseling services because of a prior criminal conviction. For purposes of 19 this section, the relevancy of a licensee's prior criminal conviction shall 20 be evaluated pursuant to section 67-9411, Idaho Code. 21

22 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 23 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
 24 passage and approval.
