## RS30513 / H0253

This is the FY 2024 appropriation bill for the Department of Finance. It appropriates a total of \$10,722,500 and caps the number of authorized full-time equivalent positions at 72.00. The budget funds four line items, which provide \$112,800 and 1.00 FTP for a mortgage examiner, \$92,600 and 1.00 FTP for a public outreach program specialist, \$73,500 and 1.00 FTP for a securities technician, and \$79,000 for investigation management software.
